

Fantastic to be recognised. Well done to everyone who worked on this project.




PROJECTS WE ARE CURRENTLY WORKING ON

Lee Knowles will be leading the 6-8 week project.






Prince Charles Hospital

GREAT FEEDBACK FROM CLIENTS

We've just modelled, specified and managed the installation of a substantially sized 48 kWp solar photovoltaic (PV) system on a building with a turnaround of two weeks.

This is an impressive feat given the pressure on building supply chains everywhere at the moment given we needed a not insubstantial 120 PV panels. Not to mention multiple contractors and teams to be mobilised at the same time including crane lifts.

We used dynamic simulation modelling to model the building and roof and used shade-casting to identify the optimal placement for the system while also maintaining access for cleaning and maintenance. The modelling also helped us identify the type of system that would deliver the required yield percentage – this one should deliver up to 5% of the building's energy use over the course of a year.

We then produced an engineering design, employer requirements/specifications and undertook client duties under the CDM regulations. We utilised our existing relationships with high-quality, trusted contractors such as **Barrie Beard Ltd** to source the system and secure an installation date within the required timescale.


We oversaw each phase of work including testing of all systems and specifying how maintenance and monitoring should be adopted into business-as-usual operations. (If PV panels are not maintained and cleaned frequently it impacts on the amount of electricity produced.)

The details of the system have been digitised and added to our unique EDGE APM software that helps maintain a 'golden thread' of digital information on a building, a key requirement of the Building Safety Act 2022. This also facilitates future asset management decisions and energy data monitoring.

The building has achieved a 'B' EPC rating ahead of the government's proposed legislative timetable of 2030.

Ian Scott, a senior facilities manager at @MAPP, the managing agents at the site commented: "The PV installation recently carried out and managed by EVORA EDGE went extremely smoothly and was very impressive. The project was set up perfectly, well managed during the fit out and feedback was provided at all times on progress. All care taken to ensure a smooth roll out.
